

Folding Instructions for the Fukuyama Rose


1. Start with an 8" x 8" sheet of paper. If it is colored on one side only, start with the colored side up. Fold the square diagonally from corners.




2. Fold an 8 x 8 grid.




3. Fold the corners in using the 4 x 4 boxes in the corners.



4. Align the bottom edge of the paper with the first fold down from the top. Fold only between the two diagonal lines. Then do this fold on all sides creating a box in the middle.




5. Align the bottom edge of the folded corner with the middle diagonal fold. Fold the crease except for the middle square. Do this on all sides.





6. Align the bottom edge of the folded corner with the tip of the top folded corner. Fold only to the left. Do this on all sides.







7. Two-step fold on each corner:




8. Pop out the center square by making mountain folds on the diagonal lines and making valley folds in the center square.




9. Collapse the square and fold the whole sheet in half.



10. Fold the bottom of the middle square down and fold the back of the rest of the sheet up so that the center square is on top.



11. Fold the diagonal line to the edge of the center square to create a fold that stops at the corner of the square indicated by the blue line. Do this on all sides.




12. Unfold the bottom layer and firmly crease the last fold extending along the previous crease in a mountain fold.



13. Flip over.



14. Refold the two-step fold from step #7 for each side. Clip the folds into place so it doesn't unfold as you work your way around.



15. Fold the flaps down and tuck them together like a box.






16. Turn it over and fluff it out.





Folding Instructions for the Kusudama Flower



1. Start with a 3" x 3" square of paper. If it is colored on one side only, start with the colored side down.
Fold the paper diagonally once.




2. Fold the bottom points of the triangle up to the top point.




3. Fold the inner edges of the top flaps back to the outer edge.



4. Fold the tips of the flaps back over themselves.




5. Align the two edges, but do not fold. Glue and clip these edges together to make one petal of the flower.





6. Make six petals and glue them together in pairs. Then glue the pairs together to create the flower.
